## **STATEMENT**

## OF THE RECTOR OF THE PONTIFICAL UNIVERSITY OF JOHN PAUL II IN KRAKOW

## **ISSUED ON 11 MARCH 2020**

By the decision of Jarosław Gowin, the Minister of Higher Education, all universities in Poland including the Pontifical University of John Paul II in Krakow have decided to cancel all classes and lectures for BA, MA and PhD students. The Main Library of the Pontifical University of John Paul II will be closed to the public. The decision comes into force as of 12th March and holds until 25th March 2020. All the lectures and classes, including those for the PhD students, can be conducted online. Suitable decisions should be made by the heads of individual units.

All the Dean's offices and secretary's offices work according to regular working hours.
